

Casualty Tactical Suit

Casualty Tactical Suit (K.P.T.) is developed by the company "Mederius" together with Military Medical Academy and the company "SuperMedSquad" as part of the development of the Center for Tactical Medicine.

It is designed to train mutual and self-help skills that must be performed in extreme conditions to save lives.

K.P.T. is a wearable training complex that can be put on an SP or a mannequin for training.

An important feature is active bleeding for maximum realism and training of tolerance to the sight of blood.

Key features

- Compact and easy to transport.
- Imitation of bleeding with control of blood loss volume.
- Remote start of bleeding at the instructor's command.
- Students independently search for bleeding without prompting from the instructor.
- Practicing wound tamponade skills.
- The instructor can evaluate task completion time and blood loss.
- Protection for the SP in tourniquet application areas.
- The suit is carried in a special mesh bag in which it can be washed.
- Developed and produced in Russia.
